## Art– lino printing

-Lino printing otherwise known as lino cutting, is viewed as a traditional printmaking method.

-The print made by the lino cutting is a reversal (mirror image).

To select and record from first hand observations.

Use research to inspire drawings.

Explore the potential of the visual elements of line, tone and pattern.

Draw with accuracy and add detail for effect.

Manipulate and use tools to create lino cutting.

Experiment with making marks in lino to create a printed image

Use ink to roll lino cutting and print multiple image.

Compare ideas, methods and approaches in their own and others work, and say what they think and feel about them.
