In this topic the children will be finding out about the habitat: under the sea.

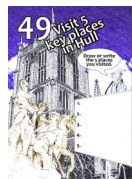
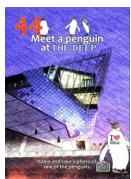
They will look at food chains and animals that live in the different layers of the sea. Children will learn a range of under the sea songs.

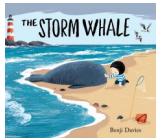
