The Romans

In this history based topic the children will be learning about the Romans and their invasion within the UK. They will also learn about significant historical events such as Pompeii's devastating volcano eruption as well as Boudicca's revolt against the Roman army.

Additionally the children will learn about some of the great inventions by the Romans and how these still affect our lives today. They will also create artwork on the Colosseum, understanding the processes of printing and how this technique is applied by various artists.

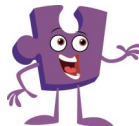
