Science

Animals including Humans

- Food passes through the digestive system from the mouth, esophagus, stomach, small intestine, large intestine (colon) and rectum. This is called digestion.
- The human digestive system It takes around 24 hours for your dinner to wind its way through the nine-metre-long digestive tract.
- Humans have three different types of teeth; premolars/molars for crushing chewing and grinding food, canines for cutting/ripping food and incisors for biting through food.
- Humans look after their teeth by brushing and flossing and ensuring that they do not eat foods high in sugar to avoid increase in plaque and tooth decay

Computing

The children will be learning about programming.

They will learn to:

- Change the speed of the sphero ball.
- Change the direction of the sphero ball.
- Direct a sphero ball through a maze.
- Debug coding errors.

History

Chronology- The Egyptian period was from 3100BC to 395AD. Cleopatra was the last Pharaoh of Egypt before the Romans took over.

Economic- The Ancient Egyptians engaged in trade with their foreign neighbours to obtain rare, exotic goods not found in Egypt.

Religion- The Egyptians believed in many Gods and mummified their dead.
