

# The Victorian Era How were children's lives different to ours?



#### Science - Materials and their uses

Materials are used for different purposes based on their properties.

Wood is used to make furniture because it is a hard and a strong material.

Metal can be used to make coins, cans, cars and cutlery.
Glass is used to make windows because it is transparent.
Some objects can be made from a range of different materials for example a spoon could be made from metal or plastic.
Some materials are not suitable due to their properties, for example paper would not make a good window.

The shape of some materials can be changed when they are stretched, twisted, bent and squashed.

#### History

**Chronology-** The Victorian Era was from 1837-1901 when Queen Victoria was Queen.

**Cultural-** Victorian classrooms were different, these included punishments, large class sizes and learning the 3R's.

**Social-** Children in the Victorian times were made to work, jobs included chimney sweeps and in the mines. Poor children were made to work for 16 hours per day.

**Military and Political** – In 1870 (151 years ago) a law was passed to make schools free to attend.
