The Dental team will come on school site twice a year to check your child/children's teeth. If you child is not registered with a dentist and need treatment 543 Dental, can provide this.

Everyone wants the best for their children, but it can be hard to know what to do as a parent as they grow up. That's where HENRY comes in.


The *Healthy Families: Growing Up* programme is free to join and helps you give your child a healthier lifestyle.
