Free Dental Treatment!

Thorpepark are working in partnership with 543 Dental. The Dental team came into school on the 4th December to check pupils teeth and to administrate the protective paste.

We were expecting two dentists, as only one available, the team did not have time to check Year 3, 4 and 5 pupils. The team will be back on site on the 8th January.

Any child that needs treatment will receive a letter. Wendy will ring parent/carers if dental treatment is urgent and explain how you can take the letter to your own dentist or contact 543 Dental for treatment.

Closing date is 15th January. It is vital that if you want a school place at Thorpepark you complete the form as soon as possible, as the last few years we have been oversubscribed. If you need support with completing the form, please ask the office or the welfare team for support.
