Promoting Reading at Home

Reading is a life skill and last week we reminded all pupils the importance of practicing reading at home. Please can you make sure your child returns their reading book and reading log each week. If you have any schoolbooks at home, please return them.

Friday will be the day when new books are sent out, unless your child needs a new book during the week. Remember your child can practice reading by going online and accessing their reading plus account.

Remember all children from Year 1 to Year 6 are members of the local library at Greenwood Avenue. You can visit the library with your child/children and loan books free of charge.



Attendance for the school is currently 94% which is lower than the National average. It is important that your child attends school regularly.

We are having an increase in holiday requests for the Summer term. Due to changes in guidance these will not be able to be authorised and could lead to a fine of £160 per child. Each adult living in the household will be expected to pay for each child. Please avoid booking holidays during term time. If your child is absent, you must contact the office with a reason.
