Wood is used to make furniture because it is a hard and a strong material.

Metal can be used to make coins, cans, cars and cutlery.

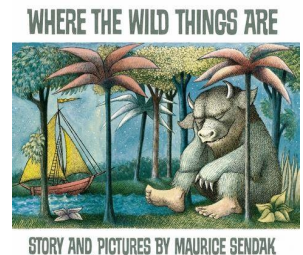
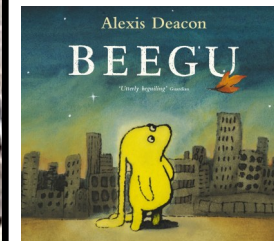
Glass is used to make windows because it is transparent.
